***It's For Meals and More!!!!***



If you apply for free or reduced meals, you may be entitled to additional benefits upon approval such as:

- **Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) Card:**

*Administered by the Virginia Department of Social Services*

To be eligible for this card students must:

1. Have a meal status of Free/Reduced or enrolled in a Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) School (Applications are not required for CEP students.)
2. Attend school remotely five days per week

- **Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB):**

**This is a temporary program to help households pay for Internet service during the Pandemic. The Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) administers this program under the direction of the Federal Communication Commission (FCC).**

To be eligible for this benefit students must:

1. Have a meal status of Free/Reduced or enrolled in a Community

Eligibility Provision (CEP) School (Applications are not required for CEP students.)
